NORTHCOM MAKES SECRET DEAL TO PUT FOREIGN TROOPS ON AMERICAN SOIL!!!

*Deschesne Meets with
General Libby to Discuss
Civil Assistance Plan*

Last month, the United States’ Northern Command (NORTHCOM) and Canada Command signed an agreement that would allow the military of one country to assist civil authorities in the other’s during times of emergency.

The so-called “Civil Assistance Plan” (CAP) allows Canadian soldiers to function with civil authorities in the United States and United States soldiers in that capacity in Canada during a declared emergency.

The CAP was not authorized by Congressional legislation, or as a treaty between two countries by the U.S. Senate.

It also seems that the respective State governors and their adjutant generals weren’t apprised of the agreement either.

Recently, the Fort Fairfield Journal questioned the Maine Emergency Management agency for

their thoughts on the plan, a plan which they weren’t even aware of.

“It came as a bit of a surprise to me,” said Maine Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management Commissioner and Adjutant General, Major General Bill Libby in an exclusive interview with the Fort Fairfield Journal.

“I’m a little disappointed that I had to learn of the (Civil Assistance) plan from the editor/publisher of the Fort Fairfield Journal.”

According to a NORTHCOM press release, published on their website, the CAP was signed by **USAF General Gene Renuart**, commander of North American Aerospace Defense (NORAD) Command and NORTHCOM; and Canadian Air Force Lt.-General Marc Dumais on February 14, 2008 in a ceremony at Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

Alternate news media covered the story on the internet as early as February 21 and the Fort Fairfield Journal was made aware of it by its nationwide network of independent, volunteer researchers on Feb. 24.

This writer mailed letters to the Aroostook County Sheriff, Aroostook Emergency Management Agency and Maine Secretary of State on February 29 for comment on this plan and followed up with Emails on March 3.

As the head of Maine’s Emergency Management system, General Libby was then admittedly made aware of the CAP shortly after his Maine Emergency Management State Director, Robert McAleer alerted him to it - at least fourteen days after it had been signed.

“Neither the governor, nor I were included in the discussions of the plan, or even aware of it” said Libby, who is the highest-ranking military officer in Maine. “Not that I think NORTHCOM has to come to us for approval, but it would have been nice to at least been included in the discussion of

the plan. It certainly wasn't appreciated at the State level that we were left out." He also indicated that it was likely most of the other State governors and their adjutant generals were out of the loop, as well.

While left out of the negotiations for the CAP, Libby claims that the use of U.S. or Canadian troops for assistance to local authorities in Maine would be up to the State, not the Federal government. "It is my understanding that in the event of an emergency, the Governor, his emergency management directors and I would determine if we needed assistance from the federal government and would then apply for it," said Libby. *As for foreign troops being used for domestic law enforcement, Libby says, "The Canadian military will not be used for law enforcement purposes."*

[Ed. Note: This is a hollow promise, because several notable *OPLAN* documents show an intent to use foreign troops and/or private military companies as a 'posse comitatus' (Ref. NDAA 2006)]

Currently, Maine law requires any federal officer who engages in State law enforcement to have completed a minimum of required training through the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, or an approved course. But, those statutes grant no authorization for foreign militaries.

Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) John Cornelio, Public Affairs Officer for NORTHCOM/NORAD in Colorado Springs agreed with Libby in a telephone interview with the Fort Fairfield Journal. "The CAP is merely an agreement between the U.S. and Canada where Canadian troops will assist the states when asked," said LTC Cornelio. "They are not intended to be used for law enforcement purposes."

However, the 2008 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) seems to contradict Libby's and Cornelio's position

by placing the sole determination and use of the U.S. military for law enforcement purposes within a state with the President alone. Section 1068* of the NDAA (H.R. 5122) says, "**The president, by using the militia or the armed forces, or both, or by any other means, shall take such measures as he considers necessary to suppress, in a State, any insurrection, domestic violence, unlawful combination or conspiracy...**"

The Canadian military's agreement with NORTHCOM may allow them into the State under the President's authority in the NDAA to "suppress in a State, any insurrection, domestic violence, unlawful combination or conspiracy, if it so hinders the execution of the laws of that State, and of the United States within the State." **Clearly this portion of the NDAA is intended to authorize the use of the U.S. military for law enforcement within a State, under the President's discretion, and allows the Canadian military to also be used upon request from NORTHCOM under the CAP.**

There is no mention in the NDAA of a State governor's input in the determination to use U.S. troops within his/her State.

Instead, those measures are left solely to the U.S. President alone. The language, "or any other means," in the law *seems to imply the use of foreign troops* in addition to, or in lieu of, U.S. troops to enforce the laws of the State and the United States *in the event the state's constituted authorities are either unable, or refuse to provide said enforcement.*

The text of the agreement with the Canadian military is not being made public. "It is marked, 'For Official Use Only,'" said General Libby.

"The CAP is an Operational Order and all Operational Orders fall under the category 'For Official Use Only,'" said LTC Cornelio.

"Certainly if we were designing an Operational Order for use in Iraq we wouldn't want that made public. But, the CAP is different and we are working on authorizing it for release to the public as soon as possible."

LTC Cornelio promises a copy of the CAP will be made available to the Fort Fairfield Journal as soon as it's released.

The NDAA allows the President to use the military to enforce the laws of the United States within a State when a State "opposes or obstructs the execution of the laws of the United States or impedes the course of justice under those laws."

The State of Maine is currently refusing to abide by and adopt provisions of the REAL ID Act, which is a federal law.

Under section 1068, of the NDAA, Maine could be considered in a state of "insurrection" by refusing to comply with REAL ID, thus activating the language and intent of the NDAA against them. The deadline for compliance with REAL ID is May 11, 2008. *The State of Maine has indicated it has no intention of filing for an extension for compliance.*

[Ed. Note: Hooray for Maine! Let's hope that another 36 states do the same thing!]

There is an old maxim that says militaries are formed and trained primarily to kill people and break things. Militaries, by their nature are not disaster relief organizations. "NORTHCOM is an operational command center, it has no troops assigned to it," said LTC Cornelio. "We are in command of both aspects of the military - the war side and the disaster relief side. We determine which to use based upon our assigned mission."

Since the only time Maine would apply for assistance "out of house" is when it is determined that it can't handle the emergency "in house" with its own authorities,

General Libby was asked what would happen if a foreign military were invited into the State and decided to take control of the police, legislature or governor. By inviting in the Canadian military, we would admittedly not have enough people in the State to handle that type of situation. "The plan doesn't address that question," he said.

The NDAA does not deal with innocuous events such as water purification, but instead deals specifically with the use of the U.S., and now through the CAP, Canadian militaries to enforce State and U.S. law within a state under the President's direction... **A plan that General Libby admits was entered into with no input or foreknowledge of the respective States' legislatures, Emergency Management Directors, Adjutant Generals or Governors.**



THE PLANNED NORTH AMERICAN UNION MILITARY

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS - The North American Union military began shoring up support among member nations last month as leaders from [U.S. and Canadian Commands signed an agreement \(<http://www.northcom.mil/News/2008/021408.html>\)](#) to allow each other's military forces to police the citizenry in domestic law enforcement during emergencies in each other's respective countries.

"This document is a unique, bilateral military plan to align our respective national military plans to respond quickly to the other nation's requests for military support of civil authorities," Renuart said in a press release from U.S. Northern Command.

"The signing of this plan is an important symbol of the already strong working relationship between Canada Command and U.S. Northern Command," Dumais said. "Our Commands were created by our respective governments to respond to the defense and security challenges of the twenty-first century, and we both realize that these and other challenges are best met through cooperation between friends."

Jerome Corsi, from World Net Daily reports, "The agreement, defined as a Civil Assistance Plan, was not submitted to Congress for approval, nor did Congress pass any law or treaty specifically authorizing this military agreement to combine the operations of the armed forces of the United States and Canada..."

Historically, the U.S. Military, and even more so a foreign military, has been prohibited from exercising civilian policing powers of the U.S. citizenry by the [Posse Comitatus Act of 1878](#).

However, section [1076 of the John Warner Defense Authorization Act](#) (<http://thomas.loc.gov/cgi-bin/query/F?c109:6:./temp/%7Ec109lgG12r:e939907>;) (H.R. 5122) granted the President bold new powers to use the (U.S.) military for domestic law enforcement within the states under his discretion alone, without an invitation from the States' authorities.

The 2008 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) (H.R. 1585) repeals portions of the former grant of emergency presidential powers from the John Warner Defense Authorization Act. However, after portions of the former act were repealed, the [2008 NDAA](#) (<http://thomas.loc.gov/cgi-bin/query/F?c110:7:./temp/%7Ec110BGsxei:e982221>;) still allows the President to use the militia or the armed forces within the States and to take measures he deems necessary to suppress "insurrections" and "domestic

violence" and also when the constituted authorities of the State are "unable, or refuse" to uphold the laws of the United States.

Since no mention of foreign militaries is extant in the NDAA, the CAP seems to be a "back door" to allow the President to bring in those foreign troops by activating NORTHCOM and NORTHCOM bringing in those foreign militaries that are partnered with them.

It is important to note that the Canadian military's soldiers have sworn no oath of allegiance to the United States, or U.S. Constitution, but could potentially be armed and in-country assisting civilian law enforcement officers in their law enforcement duties.

By the nature of foreign troops under quasi-federal control, there is a potential for their usurpation of the authority of local law enforcement. Senator Susan Collins (R-ME), ranking member of the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee attempted to downplay the seriousness of foreign troops exercising civilian law enforcement duties inside the U.S.; "It should be important to note that this is not a mutual defense plan, but it does allow one nation's military to provide civil support assistance to their neighbor in the time of a civil emergency such as during floods, forest fires, hurricanes, earthquakes as well as to help deal with the effects of a terrorist attack in order to save lives, prevent human suffering and mitigate damage to property," said Senator Collins. "Many states along the northern border have a number of close knit communities that exist on both sides of the border."

Senator Collins refused to address the concerns of a foreign military operating in the U.S. without an oath of allegiance to protect and defend the Constitution, or appropriate training in the respective states' Criminal Justice

Academy as is required of the local law enforcement officers they would be assisting.

Most states in the U.S. have provisions in their laws that deal with the exercise of police powers by members of federal agencies (but not foreign militaries). In Maine law, for example, those requirements can be found at 25 MRSA section 1502-A. Specifically stated therein are requirements for training in certain aspects of law before federal officers may exercise state law enforcement powers. **However, there is no mention of foreign military troops providing those same law enforcement services.**

The purpose of these types of laws is to provide some certainty that anybody with a badge and a gun who sets out to enforce state law; a) has at least some idea what state law says (and strictly Federal law enforcement training doesn't usually go into specifics of this), and b) has sufficient knowledge, perhaps at least equal to that imparted to local reserve police officers, regarding proper application of force in various situations in accordance with the states' laws.

"As I understand it, this is not a completely new concept," said Jen Burita, a spokesperson for Senator Collins' D.C. office. "Van Buren Fire Department, for example, recently was backup on a fire in Canada."

The parallel between fire departments and full-fledged militaries providing aid is not congruent, since firefighters are not an armed military force with the potential to use machine guns, tanks and armored personnel carriers against the public during civilian policing duties.

Others have argued that the Canadian soldiers would be a good "extra pair of hands." However, even before we give our own soldiers or police a gun, they have to swear an oath of allegiance to the

United States and to preserve and protect the U.S. Constitution. The Canadian soldiers, benevolent though they may be, have sworn no oath of allegiance or sworn to protect and defend our Constitution - nor should we expect them to. **In the event "extra hands" are needed in an emergency, the Sheriff, County Emergency Management Director and Governor have full power and authority to enlist volunteers or paid employees out of their own citizenry and use them to those ends. Then, they at least get to keep control at the local level without submitting to a foreign military bureaucracy.**

It is key to note that U.S. Northern Command is empowered to protect U.S. "interests", but admittedly not the Constitutional rights of the citizenry, since there is no mention of said rights in its mission statement.

As the North American Union's Military HQ, USNORTHCOM's [Area of Responsibility](http://www.northcom.mil/About/index.html) (<http://www.northcom.mil/About/index.html>) includes air, land and sea approaches and encompasses the continental United States, Alaska, Canada, Mexico and the surrounding water out to approximately 500 nautical miles. It also includes the Gulf of Mexico and the Straits of Florida. The commander of USNORTHCOM is responsible for theater security cooperation with Canada and Mexico.

"If the establishment was really supportive of protecting U.S. national sovereignty, why on earth would they allow USNORTHCOM to establish an agreement with Canada that allows their military to support our military during civil emergencies?" queried independent journalist, Lee Rogers.

"Clearly the U.S. government is ratcheting up their plans for martial law and using the phony threat of homegrown terrorism as

an excuse to implement their militarized police state agenda."

As a sort of pre-introduction "soft sell" to the merger of both countries' armed forces, NORAD and NORTHCOM provided a joint color guard for this year's Superbowl, with Canadian troops included in the ceremony.

Last Fall, the U.S., Mexico and Central America entered into an agreement to merge police agencies at the Merida Summit, as reported in the [Fort Fairfield Journal, Feb. 27, 2008 \(page 1\)](http://null/ffj_02270801b.htm). http://null/ffj_02270801b.htm

The North American Union was formed by fiat in May, 2005 by U.S. President George W. Bush; Mexican President, Vicente Fox; and Canadian Prime Minister, Paul Martin. Later that year, Mexican troops were assisting local law enforcement and Emergency Management agencies in Texas during hurricane Katrina while the U.S. BATF was exercising law enforcement duties in Mexico via their "[Southern Borders Initiative](http://www.state.gov/r/pa/prs/ps/2007/oct/93800.htm)." <http://www.state.gov/r/pa/prs/ps/2007/oct/93800.htm>

To date, no formal treaty has been ratified by the U.S. Senate to allow for U.S. involvement in said Union, [strategic and prosperity partnership](http://www.spp.gov) (<http://www.spp.gov>) or any other merger of U.S. police and military units with foreign countries. But, the U.S. Congress and Senate are moving forward with the necessary funding to implement said mergers despite that fact.

While politicians refuse to refer to a "North American Union" by name, they are moving forward with all of the necessary mergers and bilateral agreements between police, fire, military, industry, and economies that would be necessary to facilitate such a Union in the first place.

It should give you little confidence to know that all nine justices have degrees from Ivy League schools and eight are from Harvard. Too many judges do not follow the Constitution in their rulings. PRISON RELEASE IDEA ‘AN OUTRAGE’, SAYS CCRKBA; ADVISES CITIZENS TO ARM THEMSELVES

BELLEVUE, WA – Reports that state lawmakers are considering the release of thousands of prison inmates across the country to save money amount to a public outrage, the Citizens Committee for the Right to Keep and Bear Arms said today.

The Associated Press reported Friday morning that legislators in several states are considering the move to prop up state budgets. One report said those released might include “drug addicts, thieves and even violent criminals.”

“Before we waste time wondering what raving lunatics are behind this idea,” said CCRKBA Chairman Alan Gottlieb, so-author of America Fights Back: Armed Self-Defense in a Violent Age, published by Merril Press, “it seems more prudent to advise the citizens who are faced with this ominous proposal that now would be a good time to start exercising their constitutional right to keep and bear arms. After all, the message that this sends to the public seems pretty simple: If you don’t own a gun, get one. If you’re not licensed to carry, you better apply now because cash-strapped state lawmakers obviously don’t care about the crime wave they’re about to unleash.”

At least eight states, according to the report, are considering early inmate releases to save money. The list includes **Kentucky**, California, Mississippi and Rhode Island; all states with serious budget crises on their hands.

“This idea is beyond crazy,” Gottlieb observed. “It borders on criminal malfeasance. With all the billions of dollars that Americans pay in taxes, it is both alarming and pathetic that legislatures find themselves without the funds to provide basic public safety, and that

includes funding prisons to keep criminals where they belong, instead of turning them loose to prey on the public. Maybe instead of releasing hardened criminals, state governments should release a lot of bureaucrats to the unemployment lines. Lawmakers whose wasteful spending practices put their budgets in this mess ought to be held accountable in November.

“This is a wake-up call for all taxpayers – gun owners and non-gun owners alike – to start asking some very tough questions about how lawmakers are spending their money,” he concluded. “In the meantime, realizing that local police are already outmanned and stretched to the limit, citizens will have to take a greater responsibility for their own safety, and that includes being armed. The same lawmakers who typically support laws to take our guns are now leaving the public with no alternative but to arm themselves.”

MONEY & MARKETS: IS IT OVER?

With the current action in the markets, there are two main questions that every investor is asking: Has the subprime crisis passed? And is the commodity boom over?

In this issue, I'll give you my answers, plain and simple, to both questions — via the fundamental forces behind each and some old-fashioned common sense. So let's get started...

First, Has the Subprime Crisis Passed? No. I think it's far from over. Here are five reasons why ...
#1: We're only nine months into the crisis.

Financial crises are rarely ever that short. And the sheer size and scope of the subprime crisis makes this larger than any crisis seen since the Great Depression, almost guaranteeing that it's not even remotely over.

#2: Banking experts put the losses at more than \$600 billion. But only \$180 billion has been written off so far.

Even if the bankers are wrong, and there is only a total of \$300 billion in losses, then we're still just slightly more than halfway through the crisis, with more losses and surprises surely to come.

#3: The Federal Reserve has pumped at least \$800 billion of new money and credit into the economy.

This rush to artificially stimulate the economy indicates the Fed fears that the crisis is even bigger than the \$600 billion loss estimated by the banking industry.

#4: The big surge in home foreclosures is yet to come.

There are 1.5 million loans, representing 40% of the outstanding subprime adjustable mortgages, scheduled to reset this year. Already, more than one in every 20 home mortgages and one in every five subprime mortgages are delinquent, while foreclosures are at record highs.

#5: No one knows the extent of the damage in the derivatives markets.

There could be \$100 billion or one TRILLION in losses. Bear Stearns could be the only investment banker to collapse, or there could be more casualties and more Fed bailouts.

Therein lies the problem: No one really knows for sure how much bad debt there is, nor is anyone entirely sure where it is.

Today's complex derivatives markets involve tens of thousands of players, hundreds of thousands of transactions, and all sorts of loopholes that have taken the losses off of balance sheets. So it's like

trying to find a cancer that is moving around all the time.

The Fed may have found some of the malignancy with Bear Stearns and cut it out. But who knows if, when, and where the cancer will appear next.

Personally, I think the crisis is much deeper than most are willing to admit at this time...

Otherwise, the Fed would not have opened its lending to investment bankers, effectively throwing out the rule book on central banking and becoming the true lender of last resort for virtually all financial institutions, not just commercial banks!

Second, Is the Commodity Boom Over?

I don't think so! In fact, I believe commodity prices are just beginning to move into position for an unprecedented spike to the upside. Here are five reasons why...

#1: Commodity prices have not yet caught up to their inflation-adjusted prices, and remain cheap.

Gold, as I've pointed out many times, would have to trade over \$2,200 an ounce just to equal the 1980 high of \$875 in terms of today's devalued greenbacks. At \$900, it's not even half way there!

Sugar would have to more than QUINTUPLE from its current \$.1179 per pound to \$.5895 to reach its inflation-adjusted high. Wheat would have to soar almost 400% to more than \$48 a bushel, from its current \$10 level. Corn would have to increase almost 600% to \$34 a bushel, from its current \$5.07. Tin would have to jump more than 400%.

Nearly every natural resource under the sun would have to gain anywhere from 200% to as much as 600% just to catch-up with inflation- And those gains do not factor in that...

#2: The Fed is pumping in money like there's no tomorrow, which

will continue to devalue the dollar as far as the eye can see.

As I mentioned earlier, the Fed has already pumped some \$800 billion of new money and credit into the economy, with more money pumping surely ahead.

Even considering that the economy is in a credit contraction in the private sector, this new fiat money is sure to expand the money supply, by as much as 5 to 1 in my estimate (in a normal economy, each \$1 the Fed prints creates on average \$10 of new money via lending and relending).

That's at least four trillion new dollars that will eventually work its way through the economy... depressing the value of those dollars.

That's not to say there won't be short-term rallies in the dollar, like we're seeing now. Of course there will be. But the long-term trend for the dollar is clearly DOWN. That, in turn, will push commodity prices even higher.

#3: Demand remains at record highs for almost all commodities.

There's not one shred of evidence that demand is slowing for any of the world's major natural resources and commodities, even as the U.S. economy sinks.

To the contrary, demand for oil, copper, grains, and base metals remain at record highs, with no let up in sight.

#4: Supplies remain tight as a drum.

Not just in oil, but also in copper, where there's only three days worth of global supplies on the shelves ... in gold ... and in grains, where supplies are at 30-year lows. Almost every commodity on the planet is experiencing severe supply constraints for a variety of reasons. From soaring demand... to underinvestment in infrastructure... to disruptions due to terrorism and geo-politics.

#5: Major commodity booms tend to last at least 11 years, with super booms lasting as long as 21

years.

Historically, most commodity bull markets tend to span 11 years, with super cycles stretching out as many as 21 years. That means the current boom in commodities should not peak until at least 2012, indicating four more years of prices rising MUCH higher.

But odds are high that we are in another super cycle commodity boom, which would mean we wouldn't see the top in commodities until 2022!

So as you can see, the commodity boom is far from over, in my opinion.

Right now we're merely witnessing a pause in the uptrend, and being given an opportunity to add to positions.

Indeed, if there's one chart that says it all about the commodity boom, it's gold. Notice on this monthly chart how gold remains well above breakout levels. Gold's chart action is exceptionally bullish for the long-term.

What Should You Do Now?

A rudimentary understanding of historical precedents and common-sense analysis dictates that you should ...

A. Assume the subprime crisis is not over. That means you should continue to steer clear of U.S. real estate, and almost all stocks (with the exception of natural resource plays). Also continue to steer clear of corporate bonds and U.S. Treasuries, which I believe are disasters waiting to happen.

B. Use pullbacks in commodities to buy. That's especially true if you're not already in these markets. In my opinion, everyone should own...

1. Gold through the streetTRACKS Gold Trust (GLD) and gold stocks via mutual funds like the Tocqueville Gold Fund (TGLDX).

2. Oil via the United States Oil Fund ETF (USO), which tracks the price of oil, and a solid oil fund like the Fidelity Select Energy Fund (FSENX).

USA 2008: THE GREAT DEPRESSION

Food stamps are the symbol of poverty in the US. In the era of the credit crunch, a record 28 million Americans are now relying on them to survive – a sure sign the world's richest country faces economic crisis

We knew things were bad on Wall Street, but on Main Street it may be worse. Startling official statistics show that as a new economic recession stalks the United States, a record number of Americans will shortly be depending on food stamps just to feed themselves and their families.

Dismal projections by the Congressional Budget Office in Washington suggest that in the fiscal year starting in October, 28 million people in the US will be using government food stamps to buy essential groceries, the highest level since the food assistance programme was introduced in the 1960s.

The increase – from 26.5 million in 2007 – is due partly to recent efforts to increase public awareness of the programme and also a switch from paper coupons to electronic debit cards. But above all it is the pressures being exerted on ordinary Americans by an economy that is suddenly beset by troubles. Housing foreclosures, accelerating

jobs losses and fast-rising prices all add to the squeeze.

Emblematic of the downturn until now has been the parades of houses seized in foreclosure all across the country, and myriad families separated from their homes. But now the crisis is starting to hit the country in its gut. Getting food on the table is a challenge many Americans are finding harder to meet. As a barometer of the country's economic health, food stamp usage may not be perfect, but can certainly tell a story.

Michigan has been in its own mini-recession for years as its collapsing industrial base, particularly in the car industry, has cast more and more out of work. Now, one in eight residents of the state is on food stamps, double the level in 2000. "We have seen a dramatic increase in recent years, but we have also seen it climbing more in recent months," Maureen Sorbet, a spokeswoman for Michigan's programme, said. "It's been increasing steadily. Without the programme, some families and kids would be going without."

But the trend is not restricted to the rust-belt regions. Forty states are reporting increases in applications for the stamps, actually electronic cards that are filled automatically once a month by the government and are swiped by shoppers at the till, in the 12 months from December 2006. At least six states, including Florida, Arizona and Maryland, have had a 10 per cent increase in the past year.

In Rhode Island, the segment of the population on food stamps has risen by 18 per cent in two years. The food programme started 40 years ago when hunger was still a daily fact of life for many Americans. The recent switch from paper coupons to the plastic card system has helped remove some of the stigma associated with the food stamp programme. The card can be swiped as easily as a bank debit card. To qualify for the cards,

Americans do not have to be exactly on the breadline. The programme is available to people whose earnings are just above the official poverty line. For Hubert Liepnieks, the card is a lifeline he could never afford to lose. Just out of prison, he sleeps in overnight shelters in Manhattan and uses the card at a Morgan Williams supermarket on East 23rd Street. Yesterday, he and his fiancée, Christine Schultz, who is in a wheelchair, shared one banana and a cup of coffee bought with the 82 cents left on it.

"They should be refilling it in the next three or four days," Liepnieks says. At times, he admits, he and friends bargain with owners of the smaller grocery shops to trade the value of their cards for cash, although it is illegal. "It can be done. I get \$7 back on \$10."

Richard Enright, the manager at this Morgan Williams, says the numbers of customers on food stamps has been steady but he expects that to rise soon. "In this location, it's still mostly old people and people who have retired from city jobs on stamps," he says. Food stamp money was designed to supplement what people could buy rather than covering all the costs of a family's groceries. But the problem now, Mr Enright says, is that soaring prices are squeezing the value of the benefits.

"Last St Patrick's Day, we were selling Irish soda bread for \$1.99. This year it was \$2.99. Prices are just spiralling up, because of the cost of gas trucking the food into the city and because of commodity prices. People complain, but I tell them it's not my fault everything is more expensive."

The US Department of Agriculture says the cost of feeding a low-income family of four has risen 6 per cent in 12 months. "The amount of food stamps per household hasn't gone up with the food costs," says Dayna Ballantyne, who runs a food bank in Des Moines, Iowa. "Our clients are

finding they aren't able to purchase food like they used to."

And the next monthly job numbers, to be released this Friday, are likely to show 50,000 more jobs were lost nationwide in March, and the unemployment rate is up to perhaps 5 per cent.

U.S. LEGAL SYSTEM IS CORRUPT BEYOND RECOGNITION, JUDGE TELLS HARVARD LAW SCHOOL

Judge Edith H. Jones of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit talks to members of Harvard Law School's Federalist Society. Jones said that the question of what is morally right is routinely sacrificed to what is politically expedient.

The American legal system has been corrupted almost beyond recognition, Judge Edith Jones of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, told the Federalist Society of Harvard Law School on February 28. She said that the question of what is morally right is routinely sacrificed to what is politically expedient. The change has come because legal philosophy has descended to nihilism.

"The integrity of law, its religious roots, its transcendent quality are disappearing. I saw the movie 'Chicago' with Richard Gere the other day. That's the way the public thinks about lawyers," she told the students.

"The first 100 years of American lawyers were trained on Blackstone, who wrote that: 'The law of nature - dictated by God himself - is binding in all counties and at all times; no human laws are of any validity if contrary to this; and such of them as are valid derive all force and all their authority from this original.' The Framers created a government of limited power with this understanding of the rule of law - that it was dependent on transcendent religious obligation," said Jones.

She said that the business about all of the Founding Fathers being deists is "just wrong," or "way overblown." She says they believed in "faith and reason," and this did not lead to intolerance.

"This is not a prescription for intolerance or narrow sectarianism," she continued, "for unalienable rights were given by God to all our fellow citizens. Having lost sight of the moral and religious foundations of the rule of law, we are vulnerable to the destruction of our freedom, our equality before the law and our self-respect. It is my fervent hope that this new century will experience a revival of the original understanding of the rule of law and its roots."

"The answer is a recovery of moral principle, the sine qua non of an orderly society. Post 9/11, many events have been clarified. It is hard to remain a moral relativist when your own people are being killed."

According to the judge, the first contemporary threat to the rule of law comes from within the legal system itself.

Alexis de Tocqueville, author of *Democracy in America* and one of the first writers to observe the United States from the outside looking-in, "described lawyers as a natural aristocracy in America," Jones told the students. "The intellectual basis of their profession and the study of law based on venerable precedents bred in them habits of order and a taste for

formalities and predictability." As Tocqueville saw it, "These qualities enabled attorneys to stand apart from the passions of the majority. Lawyers were respected by the citizens and able to guide them and moderate the public's whims. Lawyers were essential to tempering the potential tyranny of the majority.

"Some lawyers may still perceive our profession in this flattering light, but to judge from polls and the tenor of lawyer jokes, I doubt the public shares Tocqueville's view anymore, and it is hard for us to do so.

"The legal aristocracy has shed its professional independence for the temptations and materialism associated with becoming businessmen. Because law has become a self-avowed business, pressure mounts to give clients the advice they want to hear, to pander to the clients' goal through deft manipulation of the law. . While the business mentality produces certain benefits, like occasional competition to charge clients lower fees, other adverse effects include advertising and shameless self-promotion. The legal system has also been wounded by lawyers who themselves no longer respect the rule of law,"

The judge quoted Kenneth Starr as saying, "It is decidedly unchristian to win at any cost," and added that most lawyers agree with him.

However, "An increasingly visible and vocal number apparently believe that the strategic use of anger and incivility will achieve their aims. Others seem uninhibited about making misstatements to the court or their opponents or destroying or falsifying evidence," she claimed. "When lawyers cannot be trusted to observe the fair processes essential to maintaining the rule of law, how can we expect the public to respect the process?"

The judge quoted George Washington who asked in his

Farewell Address, "Where is the security for property, for reputation, for life, if the sense of religious obligation desert the oaths in courts of justice?"

Similarly, asked Jones, how can a system founded on law survive if the administrators of the law daily display their contempt for it?

"Lawyers' private morality has definite public consequences," she said. "Their misbehavior feeds on itself, encouraging disrespect and debasement of the rule of law as the public become encouraged to press their own advantage in a system they perceive as manipulatable."

The second threat to the rule of law comes from government, which is encumbered with agencies that have made the law so complicated that it is difficult to decipher and often contradicts itself.

"Agencies have an inherent tendency to expand their mandate," says Jones. "At the same time, their decision-making often becomes parochial and short-sighted. They may be captured by the entities that are ostensibly being regulated, or they may pursue agency self-interest at the expense of the public welfare. Citizens left at the mercy of selective and unpredictable agency action have little recourse."

The third and most comprehensive threat to the rule of law arises from contemporary legal philosophy.

"Throughout my professional life, American legal education has been ruled by theories like positivism, the residue of legal realism, critical legal studies, post-modernism and other philosophical fashions," said Jones. "Each of these theories has a lot to say about the 'is' of law, but none of them addresses the 'ought,' the moral foundation or direction of law."

"The problem with legal philosophy today is that it reflects all too well the broader post-Enlightenment problem of philosophy," Jones said. She quoted Ernest Fortin, who wrote in *Crisis*

magazine: "The whole of modern thought has been a series of heroic attempts to reconstruct a world of human meaning and value on the basis of our purely mechanistic understanding of the universe."

Jones said that all of these threats to the rule of law have a common thread running through them, and she quoted Professor Harold Berman to identify it: "The traditional Western beliefs in the structural integrity of law, its ongoing-ness, its religious roots, its transcendent qualities, are disappearing not only from the minds of law teachers and law students but also from the consciousness of the vast majority of citizens, the people as a whole; and more than that, they are disappearing from the law itself. The law itself is becoming more fragmented, more subjective, geared more to expediency and less to morality. . The historical soil of the Western legal tradition is being washed away, and the tradition itself is threatened with collapse."

Judge Jones concluded with another thought from George Washington:

"Of all the dispositions and habits which lead to prosperity, religion and morality are indispensable supports. In vain would that man claim the tribute of patriotism who should labor to subvert these great pillars of human happiness - these firmest props of the duties of men and citizens."

2008: BUSH'S
THOUGHT-CRIME BILL**

This bill – S.1959 – was signed by *der Führer*, George Bush, in January. **What follows are Congressman Ron Paul's comments immediately prior to passage:**

Madame Speaker, I regret that I was unavoidably out of town on October 23, 2007, when a vote was taken on HR 1955, the Violent Radicalization & Homegrown Terrorism Prevention Act. Had I been able to vote, I would have voted against this misguided and dangerous piece of legislation. This legislation focuses the weight of the US government inward toward its own citizens under the guise of protecting us against "violent radicalization."

I would like to note that this legislation was brought to the floor for a vote under suspension of regular order. These so-called "suspension" bills are meant to be non-controversial, thereby negating the need for the more complete and open debate allowed under regular order. It is difficult for me to believe that none of my colleagues in Congress view HR 1955, with its troubling civil liberties implications, as "non-controversial."

There are many causes for concern in HR 1955. The legislation specifically singles out the Internet for "facilitating violent radicalization, ideologically based violence, and the homegrown terrorism process" in the United States. Such language may well be the first step toward US government regulation of what we are allowed to access on the Internet. Are we, for our own good, to be subjected to the kind of governmental control of the Internet that we see in un-free societies? This bill certainly sets us on that course.

This seems to be an unwise and dangerous solution in search of a real problem. Previous acts of ideologically-motivated violence, though rare, have been resolved successfully using law enforcement techniques, existing laws against violence, and our court system. Even if there were a surge of "violent radicalization" -- a claim for which there is no evidence -- there is no reason to believe that our

criminal justice system is so flawed and weak as to be incapable of trying and punishing those who perpetrate violent acts.

This legislation will set up a new government bureaucracy to monitor and further study the as-yet undemonstrated pressing problem of homegrown terrorism and radicalization. It will no doubt prove to be another bureaucracy that artificially inflates problems so as to guarantee its future existence and funding. But it may do so at great further expense to our civil liberties. What disturbs me most about this legislation is that it leaves the door wide open for the broadest definition of what constitutes "radicalization." Could otherwise non-violent anti-tax, antiwar, or anti-abortion groups fall under the watchful eye of this new government commission? Assurances otherwise in this legislation are unconvincing.

In addition, this legislation will create a Department of Homeland Security-established, university-based body to further study radicalization and to "contribute to the establishment of training, written materials, information, analytical assistance and professional resources to aid in combating violent radicalization and homegrown terrorism." I wonder whether this is really a legitimate role for institutes of higher learning in a free society.

Legislation such as this demands heavy-handed governmental action against American citizens where no crime has been committed. It is yet another attack on our Constitutionally-protected civil liberties. It is my sincere hope that we will reject such approaches to security, which will fail at their stated goal at a great cost to our way of life.

Detention facility currently holds
200 children taken in midnight raids

A detention camp in Taylor Texas that currently holds hundreds of rebuffed asylum seekers who legally entered the country, half of which are children swept up in midnight raids, is a potential prime location for the enforced transfer of American citizens during a time of national emergency.

The privatized Hutto jail, which is also administered by Homeland Security and (ICE) Immigration & Customs Enforcement, currently interns political asylum seekers who came to the United States on legal visas. [Most of them are families, including pregnant women and children](http://www.counterpunch.org/mose/s12192006.html) [<http://www.counterpunch.org/mose/s12192006.html>] who have never been accused of any wrongdoing but are forced to endure squalid conditions inside literal concentration camps.

In 2004 the facility was on the verge of being shutdown due to lack of occupancy but new immigration policies, allied to the burgeoning growth of the prison industry and future plans to detain American citizens on masse, have revived the potential scope of the camp, and a [new contract to intern 600 individuals](#)

was finalized with immigration authorities in December 2005.

The facility is euphemistically called a "Residential Center," yet charges of overcrowding and poor conditions are rife, with an estimated 645 people filling a facility that has only 512 beds.

"Innocent children should not be jailed and forced to live under traumatizing and dehumanizing

Bilderberg members postulated the necessity of wiping out American patriots who oppose the New World Order.

conditions," said a statement from Texans United for Families, an organization that recently held a vigil protest at the facility. "It is bad policy and an impractical and inhumane response to a growing refugee crisis. The U.S. should seek alternatives to detention while making sure that it legislates policies that support families and keep them together and out of jail."

The Infowars team recently visited the facility and were promptly told to leave the premises before having their names taken, but not before they were able to get footage of the camp "playground" where some of the children were playing behind giant mesh barbed wire. The children were kept indoors throughout the taping and were only allowed out when the film crew left to eat lunch.

One local said that other residents of the town were completely oblivious to the fact that the camp even existed, never mind its function and purpose.

Suspicious will undoubtedly be cast as to whether the facility in Tyler is part of a wider agenda to set up a network of internment camps that will be used to forcibly detain American citizens under emergency provisions. The pretext for this was set in the summer of 2004, when thousands of protesters in New York for the Republican National Convention were forcibly detained, some for over 24 hours, without charge in an asbestos infested disused bus facility known as [Pier 57](#), or "[Guantanamo on the Hudson](#)" as others labeled it.

During the Iran Contra hearings in the 80's, previously classified information came to light about Continuity of Government (CoG) procedures in times of national crisis. The masterminds behind these programs were Oliver North, Donald Rumsfeld and Dick Cheney and the [Rex-84](#) 'readiness exercise'

discussed the plan to round up immigrants and detain them in internment camps in the context of uncontrolled population movements across the Mexican border.

The real agenda was to use the cover of rounding up immigrants and illegal aliens as a smokescreen for targeting political dissidents and American citizens. From 1967 to 1971 the FBI kept a list of persons to be rounded up as subversive, dubbed the "ADEX" list.

Since 9/11 shadow government and CoG programs that were outlined in Rex-84 have been activated, including warrantless wiretapping of all American citizens. The internment camp program is being readied for implementation [following an announcement](#) on January 24, 2006 that Halliburton subsidiary KBR (formerly Brown and Root) had been awarded a \$385 million contingency contract by the Department of Homeland Security to build detention camps.

A much discussed and circulated report, the [Pentagon's Civilian Inmate Labor Program](#), has recently been updated and the revision details a "template for developing agreements" between the Army and corrections facilities for the use of civilian inmate labor on Army installations."

The pretext given for which the camps would be used as reported by the [New York Times](#) was stated as, "an unexpected influx of immigrants, to house people in the event of a natural disaster or for new programs that require additional detention space."

Following the news first given wide attention by this website (infowars.com), that Halliburton subsidiary Kellogg, Brown and Root had been awarded a \$385 million dollar contract by Homeland Security to construct detention and processing facilities in the event of a national emergency, the [Altnet](#)

[website](#) put together an alarming report that collated all the latest information on plans to initiate internment of political subversives and Muslims after the next major terror attack in the U.S.

The article highlighted the disturbing comments of Sen. Lindsey Graham, who encouraged torture supporting Attorney General Alberto Gonzales *to target* "Fifth Columnist" *Americans who show disloyalty* and sympathize with "the enemy," whoever that enemy may be.

Respected author Peter Dale Scott speculated that the "detention centers could be used to detain American citizens if the Bush administration were to declare martial law."

By extension, one could argue that any thing contrary to the principles in the Declaration is also unconstitutional and therefore void.

Public officials can also act unconstitutionally, not just pass unconstitutional laws. This may apply to a legislator, but it mainly applies to the Judiciary and the Executive. In these instances, police officers are not merely empowered to arrest elected officials for criminal behavior, but are morally and legally bound to

refuse any orders that are contrary to the Law (the Constitution).

We recommend to our readers Jack McLamb’s Police & Military website at www.jackmclamb.com where you can become familiar with the policeman’s responsibilities to the Constitution. Most officers used to be sworn, as members of our military still are, to uphold the Constitution.
