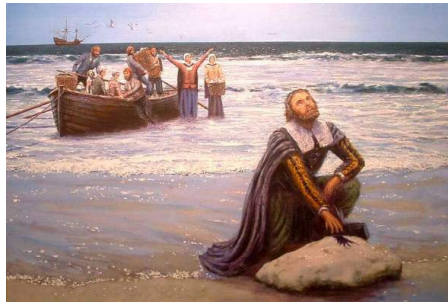


Our Nation's Founders Believed on Jesus Christ

The Christian faith was the anchor of the founding fathers of these united States. This is evident from the earliest days when the Pilgrims sought religious freedom in the new world, to the construction of our nation's signature buildings in Washington DC, to the motto "In God we trust" on our coins. DID YOU KNOW...?

- On the steps to the building which houses the U.S. Supreme Court, you can see near the top of the building a row of the world's law givers. Each one is facing one in the middle who is facing forward with a full frontal view... it is Moses and he is holding the Ten Commandments!
- As you enter the Supreme Court courtroom, the two huge oak doors have the Ten Commandments engraved on each lower portion of each door.
- As you sit inside the courtroom, you can see where, on the wall right above where the Supreme Court judges sit, a display of the Ten Commandments!
- There are Bible verses etched in stone all over the Federal Buildings and Monuments in Washington, DC.
- Every session of Congress begins with a prayer by a paid preacher, whose salary has been paid by the taxpayer since 1777.
- Fifty-two of the 55 founders of the Constitution were members of the established orthodox churches in the colonies.
- During the British bombardment of Ft. McHenry in the war of 1812, Francis Scott Key composed the poem, "Star Spangled Banner." One line is "And this be our motto - 'In God is our trust.'" Later, around 1861, Chief Justice Chase of the Supreme Court wrote the following in a letter to the Director of the Mint: "No nation can be strong except in the strength of God, or safe except in His defense. The trust of our people in God should be declared on our national coins." In 1865, Congress enacted legislation authorizing the phrase "In God We Trust" to be placed on coins.

Despite what you may hear from the media and public school Text-books, America was founded as a Christian nation. In December of 1620, long before the United States won its independence from England, the Pilgrims came to America's shores with this mission statement; "We all came to these parts of America,



with one and the same end and aim, namely, to advance the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ." - *New England Confederation of 1643*

As the American war for independence approached in the lives of the colonists, they made a Liberty Bell and inscribed upon its bronze throat the words from the Bible; "Proclaim Liberty throughout the land and to all the inhabitants thereof." - Leviticus 25:10



George Washington once said: "No people can be bound to acknowledge and adore the Invisible hand which conducts the affairs of men more than the people of the United States." Washington masterfully expressed the cry of each founding father's heart, for America had a Godly heritage.

America's founding fathers knew Christian principles and values were the only sound tenets on which to build a nation. The public and private statements, beliefs, and personal practices of each of these men illustrate America's Christian heritage.

Their original intentions are clear and unambiguous, such as the following by Thomas Jefferson: "Can the liberties of a nation be secure when we remove their only true basis, a conviction in the minds of the people that these liberties are a gift of God?"

Or the words of James Madison, who said; "The Christian religion, in its purity, is the basis and the source of all genuine freedom in government...I am persuaded that no civil government of a republican form can exist and be durable, in which the principles of Christianity have not a controlling influence." "We have staked the future of American civilization upon the capacity of each and all of us to govern ourselves according to the Ten Commandments of God."

On June 28, 1787, the Constitutional Convention was halted due to disagreements. Benjamin Franklin reminded the men that earlier, when in danger from Great Britain, they had earnestly prayed for the "Divine protection" and the prayers were heard and "graciously answered." Franklin was quick to admonish those first leaders that a nation must not forget to ask God for His blessings in this time of peace, as well as during times of war.



In another instance, Washington admired John Jay's Christian integrity so greatly that he appointed him as the first Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. Jay fervently insisted that God must be our source for success as a nation. Without His blessings, all men's efforts will amount to nothing. John Adams, our second president, stated in a letter to Thomas Jefferson that American Independence was only achieved through faith in Christ Adams'

words exemplified the attitude held by virtually all the founding fathers. Finally, George Washington used four of these major points in his famous Farewell Address, to warn against those who would claim patriotism without religion and morality. Each of these men knew that God would not watch over a nation that did not honor Him in its beliefs and practices.

What Changed?

In order for proponents of humanistic globalism to achieve one-world government, they determined that they must bring America down - which means Christianity in America must be emasculated, if not eliminated altogether. Our Republican form of government is derived from Isaiah 33:22, the most godly form of government ever adopted by humankind. In the words of William Perm, "If we are not governed by God, then we will be ruled by tyrants." Judge for yourself if we as a nation have subjected ourselves to God, and haven't we reaped the just consequences of such a course?



Our nation was great, and still shines (albeit not as brightly), because it was founded upon God's Word. But today we have allowed Him to be replaced in our schools with dialectical materialism; in our government with intrigue, mass manipulation and deceit; in our private lives with unwholesome television, print, and electronic media; in our society with public perversions & abomination; and in our churches with IRS-controlled theological content.

We have developed a mistaken notion that we can run our private and national affairs without God, and in so doing we have separated ourselves from Him!

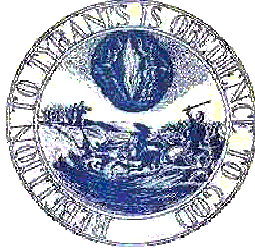
